English

The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch

We will be reading about lighthouses and the story – The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. We will then write our own stories based on this.

We will also be recapping our learning about prefixes and suffixes and compound words.

Recounts

We will be learning to write recounts of our trips to the woods and the beach. These will focus on using adjectives to describe and conjunctions to join sentences as well as remembering capital letters and full stops.

Maths

Number Bonds

We have covered number bonds in our maths lessons and will now be learning these off by heart with quick recall.

Fractions

We will be learning about halves and quarters of amounts and shapes.

Money

We will be learning about unitising with coins and making amounts using multiple coins.

Time

We will be learning about time from months and days to hours and minutes. We will use clocks to practise o'clock and half past times.

Science

Seasonal Change

The children will continue to learn about the Seasons on our Summer visit to Crenver Grove. We will be looking at what the weather is like in summer and continuing our learning about plants.

RE – Unit 1

This half term, we will be learning about the Jewish people and their practises. We will learn to build a special shelter used at Sukkot and we will learn about the story of Hannukah.

History

We will be learning about the seaside and answering the questions: When did people start going on holiday to the seaside? What made seaside holidays popular? What was the seaside like then? What is it like now? What has changed and what is the same?

RE – Unit 2

This half term, we will be learning about the environment.
How should we care for the world and for others and why does it matter?

Jigsaw PSHE – Changing Me

We will be learning about life cycles – animal and human and the changes in ourselves since being a baby.

We will look at the differences between female and male bodies (using the correct terminology) and linking growing and learning.

We will then be talking about coping with change as we prepare for the transition to Year 2.

Music / Computing

This half term, we will be learning to use rhythms and melodies along with singing songs related to the Summer. We will also use the ipads to practice our composition skills on Purple Mash.

Music / Art / Dance

These subjects will be taught on a 6 week rotation over the three classes.

Music - The children will learn about the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments in a unit called 'Round Round'.

Art – The children will look at artists' clay work, make coil pots and explore textures in clay.

PE – The children will be doing dance on Wednesday afternoon (Class 5 this half term). All the children will also continue to have a weekly PE lesson run by our Sports Coaches.
