
Cornish Word of the Week

Football


This week in the Nursery we have been learning about the three 'magic colours'. The children have been mixing the colours by painting, squirting and pouring to observe what happens. Our pumpkins are continuing by providing the children with an opportunity to paint on them and we saved some to chop up and make some delicious pumpkin soup.



This week the Reception children have practised their independence, their creativity, their science knowledge and their cycling ability amongst many other exciting things! Their Life Skills lesson encouraged them to learn how to put their coat on and zip it up by themselves. They showed great determination! The children sorted light sources during their science session this week. They found out that some objects they thought were light sources were actually reflectors, needing light from the sun to shine brightly. They looked at Van Gogh's Starry Night painting and tried to create their own starry night painting using similar colours on tin foil and printing it onto black paper. Our Get Cycling session was focusing on steering and using the handle bars to turn and follow a trail. All the children are showing confidence when balancing, braking and turning.



This week in Year 1 we have been doing computing and learning how to use Purple Mash. Look at this amazing colouring and pictures some of the children have created. We have also been learning to compare numbers in maths. In English we have been writing new stories based on 'Lost in the Toy Museum'.



This week in year 2 we have been exploring repeating patterns in art. We then used these skills to design our own festive repeating pattern to draw on a tote bag. These tote bags will be available to buy at our Christmas Fair at £2 each. The bags look absolutely fantastic and will be a fashion must have for the festive season - 'bag' yourself a bargain!
