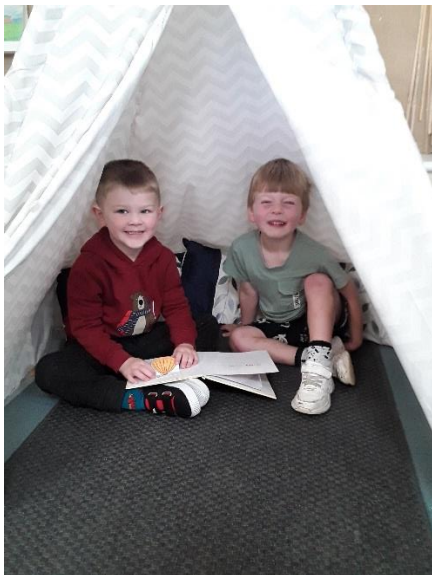

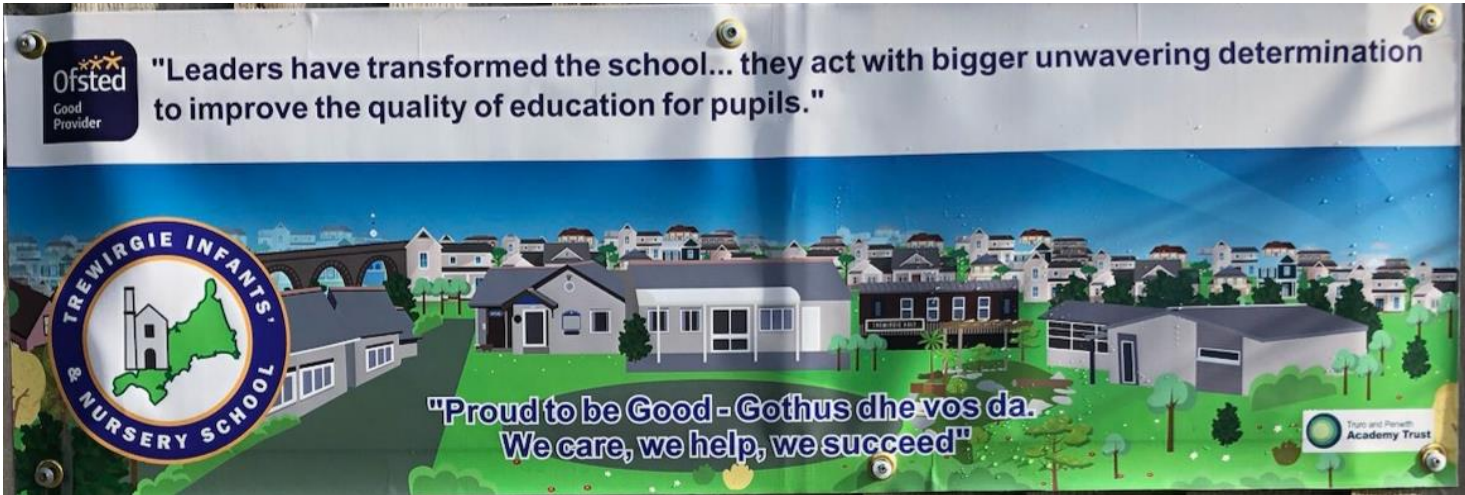
	Learner	Superstar
