Firework Poems

The children will listen to, learn and write firework poems to celebrate bonfire night.

Science

Materials

We will be learning to distinguish between the name of the object and the name of the material something is made from.

We will learn to describe materials by their properties and will set up simple tests to test these.

Seasonal Change

The children will continue to talk about Autumn and then move onto learning about Winter. Our second visit to Crenver Grove will be after Christmas.

History

Bonfire Night & Remembrance

We will find out why we celebrate bonfire night and learn about Guy Fawkes.

We will also learn about the significance of Remembrance Day and find out why people wear poppies. We will link back to art from last half term and draw a wartime soldier.

Toys

As part of our English, we will be looking at the toys children played with in the past. We will also link this to our Science learning on materials.

RE

We will be learning about what it means to belong to a faith community.

We will also be learning about the Nativity story.

Jigsaw PSHE

We will be learning about dreams and goals linked to our work on Black History Month. We will also look more at bullying and understanding the difference between falling out and bullying as well as what to do and how to get help.

Computing

Children will learn about how to keep safe online. They will also learn about some technology that is used outside of the classroom and how this helps people with tasks every day.

The children will be introduced to the KS1 platform of Purple Mash and they will learn use their login and some of the tools to draw a picture.

On a Tuesday afternoon, while the teachers have their planning time, the children will be doing Art, PE and Jigsaw with Mis Wilson, Mrs Hancock and Miss Topliss. This will be on a half termly rotation. Class 4 will do Art, Class 5 will be having Jigsaw lessons and Class 6 will do PE.

Music

Hey You! This unit is written in an Old-School Hip Hop style for children to learn about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.

Art

Drawing

The children will learn to draw body shapes and to link movement sound and marks.

Colour

The children will use the magic primary colours to explore colour mixing.

Pattern

The children will learn to experiment with relief printing. They will design and print a pattern.

PE

In our PE lessons we will be focusing on co-ordination, balance and agility. In our Friday fun sessions, we will be playing playground games and using the parachute as well as practising our main PE skills.
